

WHY AFFILIATE?

The Global Methodist Church offers a lean organizational structure, giving more autonomy and authority to local congregations while maintaining strong connectional ties for its member clergy and congregations — and ties that are rooted in the original Wesleyan standards of the Christian faith.

- Theology | A refreshed, fully aligned expression of traditional Wesleyan Christianity
- No Trust Clause | 100% local church ownership of property and assets
- **Cost Savings** | Connectional giving is currently 4% of previous year's operating income.
- Church Planting | 25% of the GMC of SC budget is allocated to fund new church starts.



To be part of a Holy Spirit inspired movement where the church makes new disciples, establishes new congregations, and witnesses to the saving power of the Triune God. The Methodist movement has historically been committed to biblical Christianity, but we like to emphasize a few of our core commitments:

- Lordship of Jesus Christ | We are unapologetically committed to a biblical and creedal understanding of Christ as fully God and fully man. Salvation is found in Christ alone.
- Holy Scripture | The Bible is the inspired word of God and contains all that is necessary for salvation. It is our final authority for faith and life.
- Intentional Discipleship | Jesus tells us to be "holy as your Father in heaven is holy." We seek to reclaim the early Methodist tradition of accountable and relational discipleship in the local church.
- Leadership Development | Every person has a spiritual gift and a calling to serve Christ and His church. We seek to equip every person to know and use their gifts to the glory of God and the good of the community.
- **Multiplication** | Jesus commands us to make disciples of all nations. An obedient church is one that seeks to multiply its witness by making new Christians and creating new churches. The creation of new churches is a high priority across South Carolina.

leader ship

The Global Methodist Church of South Carolina

has a shared structure of accountable leadership. As a member body of the Global Methodist Church, we are governed by the *Transitional Book of Doctrines and Disciplines*; we send lay and clergy delegates to General Conference and participate in denominational decision-making.



- Bishop | South Carolina's episcopal leader is Bishop Scott Jones.
- Presiding Elders | Clergy who are currently serving local congregations within the GMC of SC
- Lead Team | Shapes the ministry vision of the GMC of SC. All committees and in-state leadership bodies report to the Lead Team.

COMMITTEES

- Lead Team | Stewards the ministry vision in South Carolina. All committees report to the Lead Team.
 - Committee on Ministry | Vets, approves, and works in support of clergy
 - Committee on Annual Gathering | Plans and implements Annual Gathering
 - Finance and Administration Committee | Stewards financial resources, sets policy, and manages business matters
 - Church Multiplication and Revitalization Committee | Provides support for new church starts and assists existing congregations in seeking renewal
 - Ministry Leadership Team | Consists of Children's Collective, Youth Collective, Young Adult Collective, Missions Collective, and Lay Speaker Collective. These collectives provide:
 - 1) Networking opportunities for local church leaders
 - 2) Wesleyan best practices
 - 3) State-wide ministries such as youth retreats and mission opportunities for local churches
 - Ambassadors | Coordinate information for those considering aligning with the GMC of SC

MISSIONS

Before Jesus Christ ascended into heaven, he gave his disciples a mission to, "go and make disciples of all nations" (Matt 28:19). To be obedient to Jesus means to be obedient to his command "Go!" As Global Methodists, we live this command by partnering with God to heal the wounds found in our communities while sharing the good news that Jesus Christ is Lord. Through our Missions Collective, we will encourage every congregation to remember Jesus' Great Commission to go beyond their walls and share the good news of Jesus Christ.

DISCIPLESHIP

Jesus told his followers, "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me" (Luke 9:23). The life of a disciple is learning to live and love like Jesus by denying ourselves and taking up our cross. God's grace works to mature every believer by rescuing them from their old, sinful life and reorienting them toward a new, fruitful life in Jesus Christ (2 Cor 5:17). Historically, Methodists have gathered in small covenant groups to 1) examine their relationship with God, 2) encourage one another toward God's will and 3) care for the poor. The GMC of SC encourages every church to work toward intentionally discipling one another to see believers mature in their faith.

AND YOUTH MINISTRIES

Our Children's and Youth Ministries Collective will work to partner with local churches as well as host events to help further the discipleship of the next generation. The church was created to be a multi-generational movement of disciples. Scripture tells us, "Direct your children onto the right path, and when they are older, they will not leave it" (Proverbs 22:6). Our calling as churches is to direct our children and students by baptizing into the Church and teaching them God's truth so that they will pursue their calling in God's kingdom.

Our Young Adult Collective aims to foster connections across the state for young adults in various walks of life. In this season of life, it is important to have community and encouragement for how God will use us. As scripture says, "Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith and in purity." (1 Tim 4:12). Our goal as the GMC of SC is to remind young adults that they can be an example for churches and believers everywhere as God works through them to make disciples of Jesus Christ.

HOW DO CHURCHES JOIN THE GMC?

The first step is for the church to put the following motion before their congregation that must be adopted by a simple majority. This statement along with minutes from the meeting will need to be submitted with the church application:

"I move that _____ Church become a member congregation of the Global Methodist Church, that it affirms and endorses the doctrinal standards (Part One), Social Witness (Part Two), and church governance of the Global Methodist Church as set forth in its Transitional Book of Doctrines and Discipline, and agrees to be accountable to such standards, witness, and governance. Our leadership and trustees are authorized to take all actions necessary to implement this motion."

CONNECTIONAL GIVING

Connectional giving is based on the previous year's (January 1 to December 31) operating income. This includes what is given to the church in tithes and offerings, investment income and building use fees, rental income or other unrestricted operating income.

It is the responsibility of each church to calculate the connectional giving number and ensure both General and State levels receive the appropriate funding. The church will send 1% of the total directly to the General Church and 3% to the GMC of SC. Connectional Giving may be paid monthly, quarterly, or yearly.
